Message from the Pastor

As many of you know, our new adoration chapel is complete and in operation. I have been in there many times already, praying my daily prayers, saying the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and just spending time with our Eucharistic Lord. With the installation of the three stained glass windows, the Sacred Heart Adoration Chapel is a really special place to enter into God's presence and adore Jesus in a beautiful, quiet atmosphere. The chapel turned out just as I imagined it, and I must say I love it. Thank you once again for all who donated to our capital campaign and made it possible.

The neat thing is that from Monday to Friday evening each week we have most of the hours covered – someone is before our Lord praying for our parishes and for our parishioners. That constant prayer for us is working wonders in our parishes. The bible tells us: Pray always! Well, this is a great way to fulfill that command of God.

I have received many positive comments about how adoration has affected the lives of those parishioners who do it. People who commit to praying for an hour in the chapel each week, some during the wee hours of the night, feel refreshed, strengthened, consoled, and at peace. Have you tried to spend some time in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in our new chapel? Have you knelt in silence before our Lord, even for just a few minutes, and adored our God? I encourage you, no, I challenge you, to give it a try. Just set aside a half hour next week and come and kneel or sit in the adoration chapel. Just look at the Sacred Host in the monstrance above the altar – that's Jesus right there before you! Just soak in the atmosphere. Just be in silence. And then come back the next week and do the same. Before long you will sign up for an hour of adoration and faithfully come each week. You will feel a need to spend that hour with Christ, and you will long for that hour each week.

We have so much to pray for – spouse, kids, job, country, and future. We need that time alone, in silence, to gather ourselves each week, and keep ourselves grounded in the Lord. So, this Lent, make adoration a part of your spiritual life. At least make a short visit to the chapel each week, maybe on your way home from school or work, or on a day when you are out and about on errands. I guarantee, the benefits will outweigh the trouble in doing this. Give it a try. *Fr. Barry*

New Flooring and Pews in Holy Rosary Church

As you can see, we are laying new tile flooring in church to replace the original, nearly 40 year old, discolored linoleum. The new tile is called DuraCeramic Tile. It has an Aluminum Oxide finish, the best finish available, meets slip resistance requirements, has Antibacterial and Scotchgard Protection, and Limesone composite base. This tile has minimal grout lines and will never need to be waxed. It is a lasting, high quality floor tile and looks beautiful as well.

On Monday, March 13, the new pews will be delivered and installed. The process will be complete before Mass on Saturday, March 18. We will have two weekends (March 4-5 and 11-12) without pews and with chairs in church, but we will not be moving Mass downstairs to the cafeteria.

The Church asks us to observe fasting and abstinence on *Ash Wednesday & Good Friday*

Abstinence means not eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds Catholics from ages 18 to 59.

Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and two smaller, penitential meals (example: bread and water) on a given fast day, with no in between snacks.

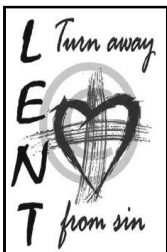

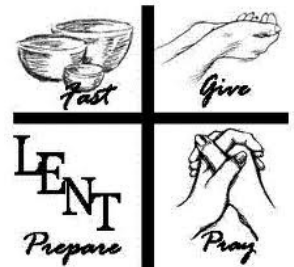
