Well, get ready, because very soon you will see workers and trucks around Holy Rosary church to begin the renovation project we've been waiting so long for. We finally got the approval from Archbishop Schnurr and the Property and Development Office of the Archdiocese and Ferguson Construction is finalizing the plans and will start digging the first week of May. They will begin with the adoration chapel on the Spring Street side of church. Then, when school's out and the festival is over, they will dig the new classrooms and school connector. We should be able to move the Preschool into the new church basement classrooms by Christmas break. The new entrance will be started when the connector and new overflow are under roof. By next spring we should be ready to put in the new parking lot asphalt and finish the grounds keeping around the new entrance.

It's all very exciting and by this time next year we will have a great place to gather and worship and educate our kids.

I hope you all are keeping up with your donations to the Capital Campaign. Of the \$2,623,510 pledged, so far we have received \$970,923, or about 37%. That is amazing, since the campaign is only a little more than a year old. Remember, the more we have in hand, the less we will have to ask a loan for. Thank you for pulling together as a parish family and supporting this wonderful and vital work of renovation at Holy Rosary. Keep it coming in!

Keep up the great prayer work, too. I hope that many more of our parishioners will use the new adoration chapel. It's going to be a beautiful place to be with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and pray for our parish and all your loved ones.

I pray also that you all have a joyous Easter Season; that Springtime gives you new hope; and that you be blessed even more as we move towards Summer.
