Message from the Pastor

I just found out a person very close to me is no longer practicing his Catholic faith. I hadn't spoken with him much over the past few months, so at a recent party I asked him very innocently what parish he was going to in the city where he worked. His reaction was more than a bit testy. At the time I didn't know he wasn't going to church anymore. Later I found out from mutual friends that he had changed a lot and indeed no longer was going to church, with a harsh opinion about the Church and her teachings. That night I was truly sad, even to the point of tears. It was like I lost a friend. But I know as baptized members of the Body of Christ, we are still united in the Holy Spirit.

I guess everyone has to wrestle with their belief in Christ and the Church. Faith is not automatic, nor is it easy. Each person has to face the reality of God, Christ, and the Church and come to accept the gift of faith. Each person has to look into their own heart and mind and measure their own conduct and morality with the message of Christ and the teachings of the Church. More times than others it is the difference between one's own life choices and the demands of the Gospel that prevent a person from embracing the message of Christ and the life of grace.

I work hard at my faith every day; trying to keep my thoughts and actions in accord with what I believe. I am convinced that God has come to us in Jesus Christ and continues His presence among us in the Church. So I am always trying to make what I think and do correspond to that truth. I pray to God that I never lose my faith. There are eternal consequences to all this and I don't want to miss out on the great promise of Heaven for all who are faithful.

And I know there is always hope. God's mercy endures forever. My prayer is for all who are struggling with their faith and especially those who are indifferent or no longer going to church regularly, that they may have the grace to accept the gift of faith and be free to follow Christ, the Way, the Truth, and the Life. *Fr. 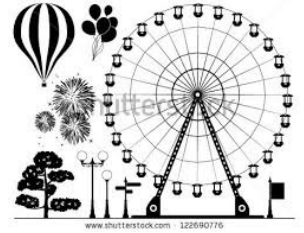
