# **Message from the Pastor**

"What do you do all day, Father?". This question was asked of me by a somewhat skeptical, but very curious parishioner the other day. What do I do all day? That's a good question. What does a parish priest do with his time...Lots!

I wake up at 7 am each morning (7:09 when I hit my snooze; which happens frequently). I get ready and then pray my morning prayers from the breviary (the priest's prayer book). I don't have a cup of coffee, nor do I turn on the radio or TV before Mass at 8:00 am; never had that habit. I try to be recollected for Mass.

After breakfast, it's into the office for mail, signing checks, checking email. Early in the week, I make plans with our CCD director, Nan Mielke, or consult with our business manager, Jess Rammel. I usually go over loose ends with Patti Folk, our parish secretary. Then there is a meeting with Marty Brown our facilities manager, more so in these past months with the renovation project.

Before lunch, I sometimes meet parishioners with various needs. Parishioners come to me with all kinds of things every day. (And I am always happy to see them.) During the day, I make hospital visits and run errands around town. When we have a funeral, I'm busy all morning through lunch.

The afternoons are devoted to work such as planning for upcoming parish events, writing my weekly bulletin article or my quarterly article for the Daily Standard, and of course, working on my homily for Sunday. I try and get in some exercise in the afternoon.

My evenings are made up of meetings (parish council, finance committee, wedding prep with couples, marriage annulments, funeral prep, etc.). I usually spend a little time at the computer at night, working on various things. Wednesday nights are busy with CCD and Youth Group. Throughout the day I stop for prayer.

After a busy week, I still have to work weekends – no rest for the wicked, they say. Saturdays can be full, with Mass, weddings, parties, hearing confessions, and baptisms. Sundays, of course, I have three Masses in the morning, flying back and forth to St. Patrick's, and maybe a baptism at noon. By Sunday afternoon, I'm spent.

So, that is a little glimpse of some of the things I do as your priest and pastor. My life is full and there is never a dull moment. It's a lot of work, but I love doing it, because I love all of you, my parishioners. Please continue to pray for me so that I may persevere in this work our Lord has given me. Thanks!
