Message from the Pastor

In my homily from last week, I mentioned maybe doing a "Summertime Confession", just to check in with our Lord and see how you are doing in your Christian life by dying to sin and living for God. We usually go to the Sacrament of Penance or Reconciliation during Advent and/or Lent. This is good. We need to prepare ourselves for the important moments of the Church's year, Christmas and Easter. Advent and Lent are penitential times and Confession is a great part of this season.

But I also think that taking time to go to Confession during Summer would be a great idea. Below I listed the various times for Confessions at area parishes. There is usually more time to make a good confession and really go deep into your souls in the summer months. What's really good is to set up a specific time with me (or any other priest in the area) for a good sit down and a heartfelt look into your life, with time to ask questions and hear the advice or spiritual direction from the priest. Just call the office and tell me when to meet you in the confessional. Anonymity will be respected if you want.

I can't stress enough, nor encourage enough, how helpful and refreshing going to the Sacrament of Confession can be, especially if it's been a while. Never fear, just come to our Lord. He is full of mercy. (I have to keep telling myself that; believe me, it's hard for me to go to confession. I know what you are going through if you have trouble getting yourself to go.) May God bless you with a contrite heart and the gift of His forgiveness.
