Christmas in July! Whenever you get a present or a special blessing at a time other than December 25th, you say: "Christmas in July!" It's a great feeling when this happens. I would love to have a Christmas in July this summer; not by receiving any gift, but by seeing the church full to overflowing at each Mass next week, just like at Christmas. I think that would be fantastic. Just remember the great atmosphere we have at Christmas with a full church. There is something about it that makes those Masses extra special. Why not have the same thing in the summer months? A packed church, everyone enthusiastic and full of energy, singing out and enjoying the spiritual boost it gives you.

I know that people are busy or on vacation during the summer months, or maybe go to a different parish sometimes. I also know that many parishioners simply don't put Sunday Mass high on their priority list. You know, this keeps me up at night.

I know we have enough people in our parishes that we can easily fill the churches every Sunday. And we have more seating at Holy Rosary to boot. How I would love to pray with and preach to and give Holy Communion to all my parishioners every week. What a "Christmas in July" that would be.

Now I don't want to just fill the church for the sake of filling up the pews with warm bodies. No, I want every individual parishioner of Holy Rosary and of St. Patrick's to experience the presence of God and take part in the Sacrifice of the Mass every Sunday.
