Update on the Capital Campaigns for Holy Rosary and Saint Patrick

Holy Rosary Construction Loan Balance is currently \$571,573.48. We still owe Ferguson \$267,080. Our current pledges are \$2,619,411.83 and we have collected \$1,632,043.55 which is 63% of our goal. We received our July disbursement in the amount of \$221,422.18. Our next disbursement will be January 2018.
