## **Message from the Pastor**

Lent is coming up quickly and we have a special parish retreat planned. It's called "A Lenten Encounter with Mercy" and it will be on four consecutive Tuesday nights beginning on February 20th at 7:00 pm in the church basement. I will be the host of this video based series from [FORMED.org](http://FORMED.org), which will cover the transforming power of mercy and love in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It is for all Holy Rosary and St. Patrick's parishioners. We as a parish family need to discover again and more deeply the rich treasure we have in God's unconditional love and abundant mercy. I hope you will all take advantage of this Lenten program to grow in your faith and in your relationship with our Loving Father in Heaven.

Also, this Lent, St. Patrick's will be offering a bible study on the Book of Exodus, Monday nights at the rectory at St. Patrick's. This bible study was offered at Holy Rosary a couple of years ago and I can attest it is a great one. The story of Exodus will come alive for you and you will find a wealth of inspirations and applications to your own life today.

I encourage you to come to daily Mass at least once a week during Lent, in order to come closer to Christ who is offering Himself for you and forgiving your sins. Daily Mass is a little different than Mass on Sunday; it can be a little quieter and more prayerful – just what you need to draw closer to God in your daily life.

As families, maybe you could do a special family prayer each week for Lent. Maybe you could offer apologies to family members and forgive each other any hurts between you. This could have a very lasting and positive effect on your family life. The weekly family rosary on Saturdays is also an excellent thing to do during Lent, even if it's just one decade. Use a scriptural rosary to make it even more interesting and engaging.

I also encourage you to attend the weekly Stations of the Cross. Spend your Friday evenings with our Lord as he makes his way to Calvary. Dinner at the K of C Fish Fry and Stations make for a great Friday night during Lent.

So, I hope we don't let this Lent go by with little effort. As a parish family let's put in the work needed to keep us all on the road to becoming saints. May God bless us all with a holy and fruitful Lent.
